

## American Legion Department of Wisconsin Department Convention, Middleton, WI 8th District Caucus, Day Two, July 17, 2021

- 1. 8<sup>th</sup> District Commander Jean Balz called the meeting to order at 0730. The colors being in place, all present rendered a hand salute. The Chaplain gave an opening prayer. The POW/MIA flag was placed on the empty chair by the Sergeant at Arms and Resolution 228 was read by Commander Balz. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice Commander led the Legionnaires in the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance. Commander Balz then led the attendees in the recitation of the Preamble to the Constitution of the American Legion.
- 2. Commander Balz declared the meeting regularly convened.
- 3. Commander Balz stressed the necessity for Posts to submit CPR reports. She then mentioned that Waushara was the only county that had not picked up its administrative packet and membership cards from Department. She asked that a Waushara County Legionnaire pick up the packet.

  - c. - 5. Commander Balz then asked if there was any new business.

  - b. The following 8<sup>th</sup> District officer positions remain open: 3<sup>rd</sup> Vice Commander; Adjutant; Historian; Chaplain; and Sergeant-at-Arms.
- 6. Commander Balz asked if there was anything for the good of the American Legion.

7. She then called on the 8<sup>th</sup> District Chaplain for prayer. The Sergeant at Arms removed the POW/MIA banner from the empty chair. Commander Balz led a salute to the colors and declared the caucus adjourned.
