





## The American Legion, Department of Wisconsin Department Convention, Oshkosh, WI 8<sup>th</sup> District Caucus, July 14, 2018

- 8<sup>th</sup> District Commander Ron Fregien called the meeting to order at 0730. The colors being in place, a hand salute was rendered. The Chaplain gave an opening prayer. The POW/MIA ceremony was performed, followed by the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance and the Preamble to the American Legion Constitution.
- 2. Commander Fregien declared the Caucus convened.
- 3. Post 63 Commander Dan Rindt turned in 40 memberships for submission at the Convention Session.
- 4. Legionnaire Matt Harn, Department Chaplain and Chaplain of 8<sup>th</sup> District Post 442, addressed the caucus. He stressed the importance of membership and encouraged the Legionnaires present to carry an American Legion membership form with them at all times.
- 5. Various candidates for Department offices visited the Caucus during the meeting and spoke about their qualification for office.
- 6. Old business:
  - a. Commander Fregien reminded all Post and County Commanders to pick up their Department Administrative packets at the end of today's Caucus meeting.
  - b. Commander Fregien called for reports from the Legionnaires who attended the Friday afternoon Convention Committee. The reports on the resolutions considered at the Convention Committee meetings were as follows:

- 8. Commander Fregien asked if there was any new business to come before the Caucus. A Legionnaire suggested that we look into forming a committee to select an outstanding 8<sup>th</sup> District member every year and present an award to the person selected. A motion to that effect was made and seconded. The motion passed. Commander Fregien said the motion would be taken up by the Executive Board.
- 9. Commander Fregien said that voting will begin at 0830 and encouraged all 8<sup>th</sup> District Delegates to vote early in order to be able to attend the Convension Sesssion at 0900.
- 10. Commander Fregien called for prayer and the removal of the POW/MIA flag from the empty chair. He called for a salute to the colors and adjourned the meeting at 0830 hours.
